Dear Parents and Carers

We are very much looking forward to welcoming your child into the Reception Class in September. This is a very exciting time as your child gets ready to begin the next stage of their educational journey with us.

I wanted to inform you of the school lunch offer that we wish to provide your child with when they start at the academy in September. Currently the government offers every child the opportunity to take a daily FREE School Meal at lunchtime whilst they are in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.

Our catering provider provide a range of hot and cold lunches that you are able to prebook in order to ensure that your child receives their choice of the day. Every day we offer:

- A hot meal
- A hot vegetarian meal
- Jacket potato with a range of fillings
- Sandwiches with a range of fillings

Each meal also comes with:

- Vegetable sticks
- The choice of a hot or cold pudding
- Water

It is our policy that we automatically register your child for this meal, however, if you would rather not take up this free provision then you are able to opt out by returning the slip below. I would however, strongly encourage you to try the provision for a number of weeks before any decision to opt out. Quite often when parents do opt out they provide a packed lunch consisting of a sandwich and a yoghurt based snack – this is actually part of the free offer above and can be pre-booked to ensure that your child receives the sandwich of their choice.

As school will be a new experience for your child, it is a good time to get them used to having a school meal as part of their new routine and we very much hope that you will take up the offer of a free nutritious meal in September.
