Dear Parents/ Carers,

In light of the global pandemic relating to Covid-19 and subsequent remote learning this term, we will continue to monitor the attendance of all children both in school and those accessing learning remotely.

Vulnerable children and young people across all year groups are expected to attend educational provision where it is appropriate for them to do so. This is so that they can gain the educational and wellbeing benefits of continued attendance. Vulnerable children and young people - regardless of year group - that have not been attending in the recent period are expected to return to school.

In addition, those children where parents are classed as Critical Workers are also encouraged to take a place in school.

It is imperative that, **if your child is not identified** as vulnerable or that of Critical Worker parents/carers, the expectation is that they are learning remotely: online registration for all year groups commences at 09:00am and your child's daily timetable has been sent previously and is on the website.

We are closely monitoring all children's attendance at this time whether in setting or accessing learning remotely. The Google Classroom gives us this information: when your child logs on, how long for and when work is uploaded. It is vital that, in order for your child to continue to make progress in their learning, they access daily.
