Dear Parent/Carer

Further to the Government announcement yesterday regarding the Covid-19 track and trace requirement of 6 days after the last day in school, we are writing to advise you that Friday 18th December will now be an Inset Day. Therefore, the last day of term will now be Thursday 17th December when school will close for the festive break. We have taken this decision so no family will be informed on Christmas Eve, 24th December 2020, that their child has to self-isolate.

A letter will be sent out shortly giving details on how to report a case of Covid-19 over the Christmas holidays.

The class bubble parties will now be held on Thursday 17th December and children are invited to come in wearing warm party clothes on that day.

To confirm, school will close on Thursday 17th December 2020 and reopen on Tuesday 5th January 2021.

Due to the change, outlined above, the Inset Day, previously taking place on the 12th April 2021 will now be cancelled and children will return to school, after the Easter holidays on the 12th April 2021.
