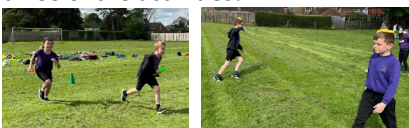

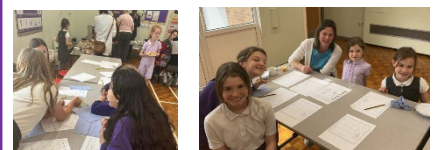
Year 1 Leave a Legacy
